E-JUST TICAD7 African Scholarship for STI

1. Background

This Scholarship program is stipulated in the "Yokohama Plan of Actions 2019" for the implementation of "Yokohama Declaration 2019" which was agreed in TICAD7 in August 2019. The objective of this program is to foster researchers and engineers who will advance STI into the future in Africa. The program is implemented by Egypt-Japan University of Science and Technology (E-JUST) and Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA)'s technical cooperation project. E-JUST started to accept students in the fall semester 2020, and the application for a new batch, fall 2022, is to be opened at the end of December 2021.

2. Outline of Scholarship Program

(1) Objective:

• To develop high quality human resources in the field of STI toward future African STI network and beyond (2) Number of Students:

- Approximately 150 post graduate students for 3 years (Approximately 50 students for each batch)
- Started receiving 1st batch students in fall 2020
- (3) Eligibility
 - Applicants shall be researchers or instructors (or potentially expected to become those) who belong to universities or research institutions in Africa and who needs to obtain MSc. degree
 - Applicants should hold a Bachelor degree in engineering or science with CGPA ≥ 3 out of 4 / Description ≥ very good/ classification ≥ second class upper or equivalent to the mentioned before
 - Applicants who are not native English speakers must submit an English proficiency certificate with the required minimum score, TOEFL iBT : 79 or Academic IELTS : 6.5.

(6) Result of International Admission 2021 (as of 30th Nov. 2021)

In Fall 2021 international admission, the initial number of applicants who applied for TICAD7 Scholarship was 442 applicants from 34 diverse countries. After conducting the eligibility check for the applicants, their number came down to 220 applicants.
